This letter is in response to an email sent from Felton Suthon on February 10, 2015, requesting a temporary construction easement on Southern University at New Orleans' property, south of the N.O. Lakefront Levee. This letter authorizes a Right of Entry (ROE) to the Orleans Levee District (O.L.D.) for the work described in the email of February 10, 2015, and is assignable to the OLD and/or its contractor for a period of four months from the date of this letter. It is understood that the ground will be regraded to improve drainage and new drainage will be installed to mitigate ponding towards the east end of the work.
