
Grades Pre-K-2: Students will be issued work packets that will be made available for pickup in the front office. They will be available starting March 18, 2020. Some assignments will be computer based such as IXL Learning, Zearn Learning and Mobi Max.

Grades 3-12: Students are expected to continue to check their teacher's Google Classroom/Google Sites for the latest information regarding classroom instruction, activities and assignments.

The scheduled LIGO field trip scheduled for Wednesday, March 18, 2020 will be rescheduled to a later date.

The last payment for 2nd semester is due March 30, 2020. The cashiers office will be open during regular business hours to accept tuition payments.

More updates will be made available on the Southern University Laboratory School website and the school's App as they become available.
