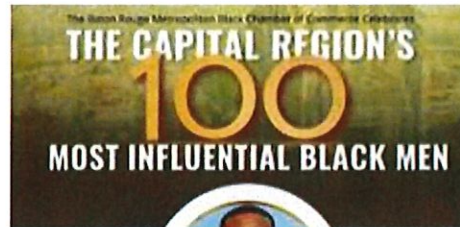
College of Nursing and Allied Health
