CSE Research Symposium

On April 21, 2023, 13 students from the **College of Sciences and Engineering** presented research on campus during the Center for Next Generation Multifunctional Composites, the Louisiana Materials Design Alliance (LAMDA) and Dow Scholars Undergraduate Research Experience (DOW SURE). LAMDA is an alliance of five institutions of higher education in the State that draws expertise from materials science, engineering, chemistry, computer science, mathematics, and physics.

Dow SURE creates opportunities for students to access research experiences and engage with Dow mentors and resources that will encourage them to pursue research careers and graduate education. SUBR has partnered in development of the Next Generation Multifunctional Composites Center in collaboration with Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge Community College and industrial partners.







On April 24, 2023 engineering students showcased their skills during the **2023 Boeing Engineering Design Project** at Pinchback Hall. Team 2 consisting of **Ashley Bryant and Myles Snowden** earned first place and received a \$1,000 prize. **Dr. Fred Lacy, Professor and Chair of the CSE Electrical Engineering Department**, assisted the student teams in preparing for the competition. The Boeing organization provides support and opportunities for the College of Science and Engineering to fund scholarships, enhance curriculum, laboratories and student projects.
