First Resident of St. Kitts and Nevis Benefits from MoU with Southern University

In a significant milestone for educational collaboration, Ike Innis, a distinguished teacher from Washington Archibald High School, became the first resident of St. Kitts and Nevis to benefit from a ground-breaking Memorandum of Understanding between the local Ministry of Education and Southern University. The Memorandum of Understanding allows citizens and residents of St. Kitts and Nevis to enjoy in-state tuition rates at Southern University institution for those seeking advanced degrees. The Ministry of Agriculture entered an MoU with Southern University in December 2023 aiming to enhance agricultural research and programmes. During the recent BoS meeting in January 2024, Mr. Innis shared his aspirations and elaborated on his mission.

Mr. Innis stated that he is both proud and humbled to be the first to undertake this journey where the acquired skills, concepts and knowledge would be used to further the Federation's development. He intends to bring developmental ideas and leave with some, also leaving a positive imprint and standard for other nationals to emulate.

Mr. Innis extended heartfelt gratitude to the academic Board of Directors at Southern University and A&M College, the Government of St. Kitts and especially Her Excellency Hadiya Claxton, Special Envoy for Investment, Development, and International Business Relations, for facilitating this landmark opportunity.


