

CAMPUS HAZING TRANSPARENCY REPORT

The Southern University System is committed to providing a safe educational environment for everyone and does not tolerate hazing by any group or individual affiliated with the System. The System expects that all students and organizations will observe and fully comply with federal law, state law, and System policies associated with the prohibition of hazing.

The Campus Hazing Transparency Report is part of a broader federal initiative, the <u>Stop Campus Hazing Act</u>, which was signed into law in December 2024. This legislation amends the Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act, to require colleges and universities to publicly disclose hazing incidents implement prevention programs, and maintain transparency in campus safety efforts.

Under the Stop Campus Hazing Act, institutions must:

- Include hazing statistics in their Annual Security and Fire Safety Reports (The Annual Security and Fire Safety Reports for institutions of the System are located at https://www.sus.edu/page/office-for-compliance-public-reports.),
- Publish a Campus Hazing Transparency Report summarizing findings of hazing violations by student organizations, and
- Implement hazing prevention and awareness programs that are research-informed and campus-wide.

The Campus Hazing Transparency Report is limited to student organizations established or recognized by the institution found to be in violation of the System's standards of conduct relating to hazing as outlined in the System's Hazing Prevention Policy, which is located at https://www.sus.edu/page/policy-search. Therefore, reports of hazing that did not result in a finding of responsibility are not included, and any student organization under active investigation will not appear in the Campus Hazing Transparency Report. Each institution of the System will update this information a minimum of twice each year.
